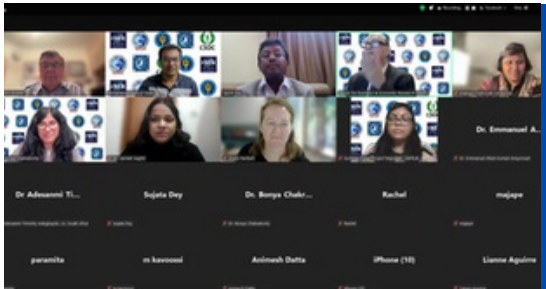

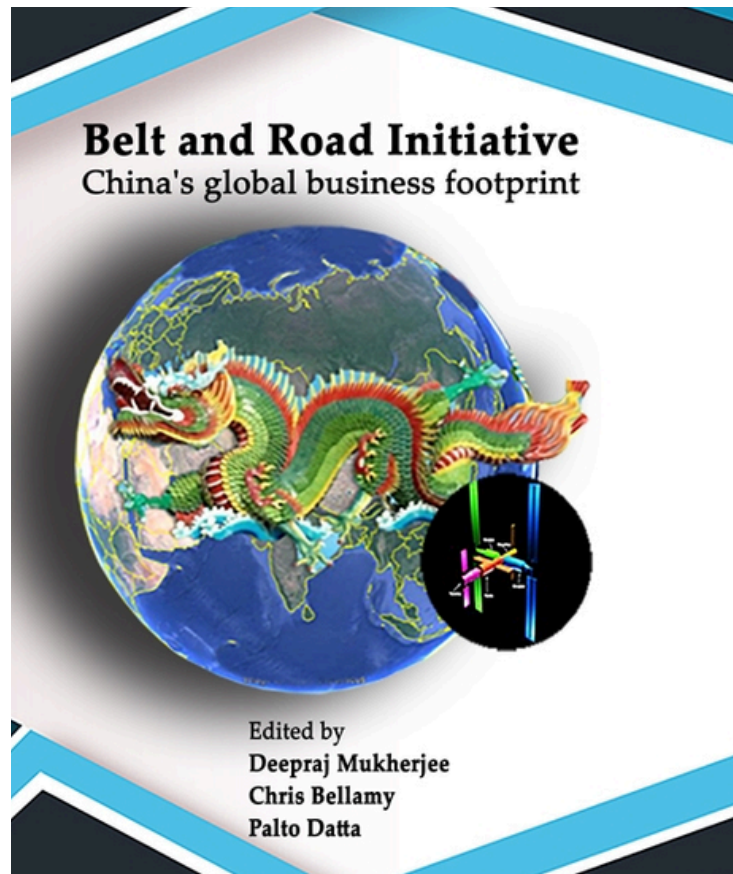

This is a precious award that is highly coveted and as such is not given out lightly. In 2026, CBER will award ten Honorary Fellowships to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Centre.

## Who can put forward nominations?

Any Fellow or Member or anyone who attended CBER conferences or published with CBER is entitled to nominate an individual.

The nominator will also be asked to provide two referees from a range of backgrounds to demonstrate the national/international impact of the nominees' work.

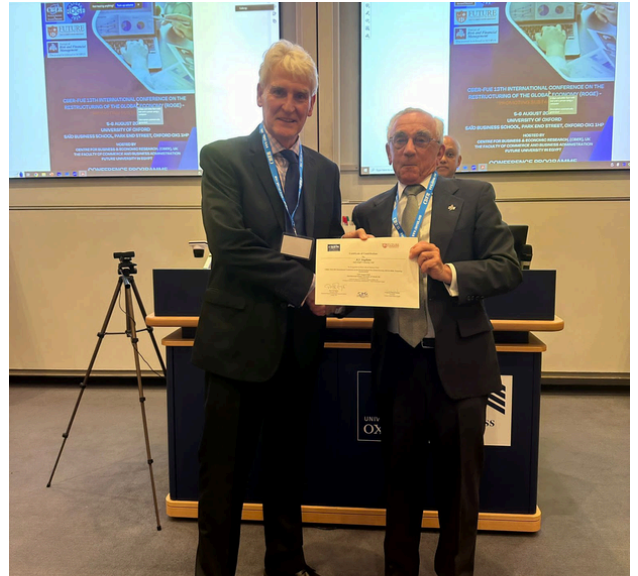
The referees may support only one nomination in any single year. The nominator may submit only one nomination in any single year.

## How can I nominate someone?

Nominations for are open all year round and can be submitted by letter or e-mail. When you submit a nomination, it will be considered at the next Awards Panel meeting.

It is recommended that they come from a range of backgrounds in order to demonstrate the reach of the nominee's work. Each must submit a testimonial showing why they think the individual has made an exceptional contribution to their area of endeavour. It is suggested that you do not make the nominee aware of the application. This will avoid disappointment should the nomination be unsuccessful.
